7. RIGHTS

- (1) This Bill of Rights is a cornerstone of democracy in South Africa. It enshrines the rights of all people in our country and affirms the democratic values of human dignity, equality and freedom.**
- (2) The state must respect, protect, promote and fulfil the rights in the Bill of Rights.**
- (3) The rights in the Bill of Rights are subject to the limitations contained or referred to in section 36, or elsewhere in the Bill.**

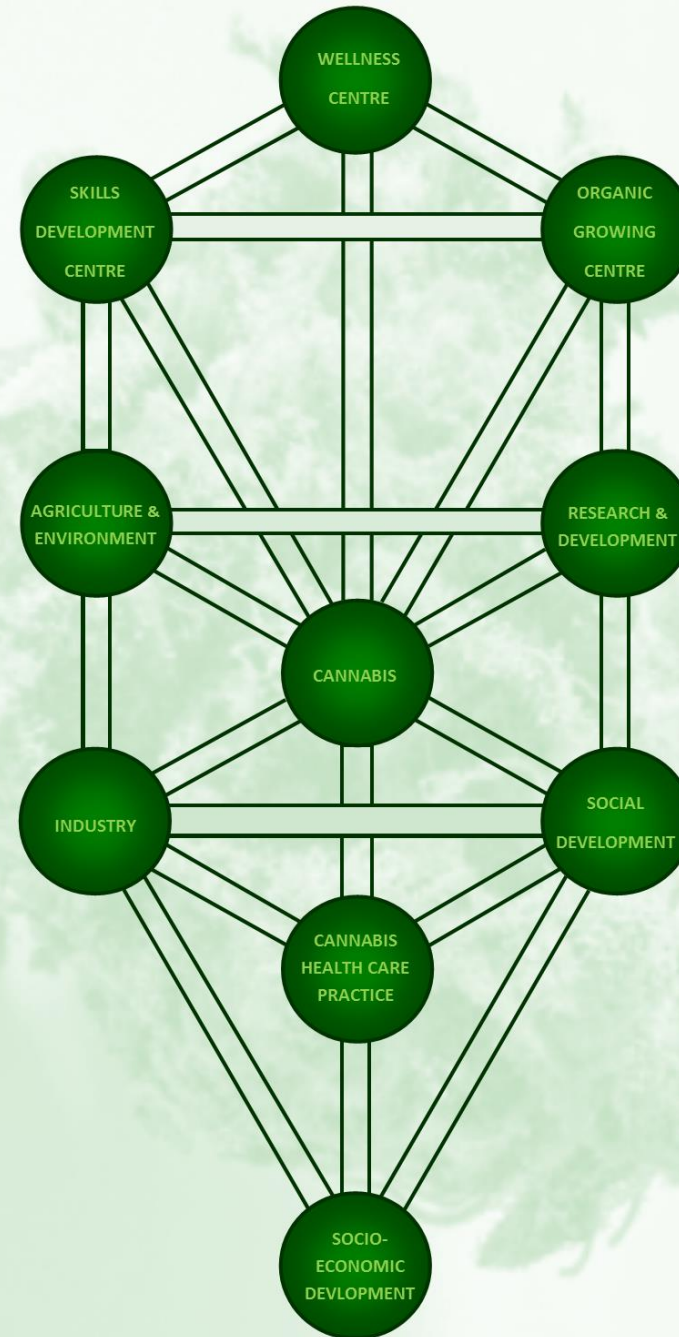

8. APPLICATION





8. APPLICATION

- (1) **The Bill of Rights** applies to all law, **and** binds the legislature, **the** executive, **the** judiciary **and** all organs of state.
- (2) **A provision of the Bill of Rights** binds a natural or a juristic person **if, and to the extent that, it is applicable**, taking into account **the** nature of the right **and the** nature of any duty imposed **by the** right.
- (3) **When applying a provision of the Bill of Rights to a natural or juristic person in terms of subsection (2), a court—**
 - (a) **in order to give effect to a right in the Bill, must apply, or if necessary develop, the common law to the extent that** legislation does not give effect to that right; **and**
 - (b) **may develop rules of the common law to limit the right, provided that the limitation is in accordance with section 36(1).**
- (4) **A juristic person is entitled to the rights in the Bill of Rights** to the extent required by the nature of the rights and the nature of that juristic person.

- (1) codify existing best practices as to decisions by medical practitioners to innovate in cases where evidence-based treatment or management is not optimal or appropriate because the available evidence is insufficient or uncertain;
- (2) enhance certainty and clarity for medical practitioners and others regarding the criteria to be applied in determining whether to innovate in the cases referred to in subsection (1);
- (3) encourage responsible innovation in medical treatment and management by supporting reasonable and logical clinical decisions;
- (4) deter reckless, illogical and unreasonable departure from standard practice; and
- (5) legalise and regulate the use of cannabinoids for medical purposes and for beneficial commercial and industrial uses.

Application

- 3. Save for section 8 which shall apply throughout the Republic, this Act shall apply only with respect to one or more pilot health services, provided that—
 - (1) within three months of the coming into force of this Act, the Minister shall identify and authorise at least one pilot health centre which shall have the capacity of treating a minimum of one hundred patients at any given time; and
 - (2) any pilot health centre shall operate in terms of, and subject to, regulations, if any.

DAGGA-SHEDDING: A Rastafarian community in the Eastern Cape has been the target of an action of eliminating dagga fields with herbicides sprayed from helicopters.

THE spraying of dagga crops in Lusikisiki, Eastern Cape, over a three-week period has been decried by the Rastafarian community who say the action has put their health at risk. Using helicopters police sprayed over 500 hectares – with a potential street value worth billions of rands –

with chemicals, police said last week. Now, the Rastafarian community says dagga shedding, a term coined in a tongue-in-cheek reference to the notorious Eskom load-shedding, has become a reality. According to the community, the move says that dagga brought in Swaziland is being destroyed by a change in weather patterns. The elder of the Rastafarian movement in Nelson Mandela Bay, Samuel Peter, is also known as Ras Judah. He says the spraying of the dagga plantation in Lusikisiki is killing his community in a number of ways. "Firstly, there are people who will sell the poisonous dagga to the street without caring for people's lives. Rastafarians will also be victims of that because they use dagga as a medicine. We would think of the people who planted the dagga who are living in the countryside. We used to support them with food and they would supply the dagga to us," Ras Judah said. He went on to say that he won't talk about the legalisation of dagga but rather its decriminalisation. "By the law we're not criminals when we are using dagga. It is a holy herb and it is part of our cleansing and spiritual path," he said. The SA Police Service, however, hold a very different view, saying in a statement, that the spraying process will go a long way to curbing accessibility to the drug. Lieutenant-General Solomon Makgato said with less of the product on the streets, prices were being driven up. Makgato said they were satisfied that their objective in keeping dagga off the streets was being adequately achieved.

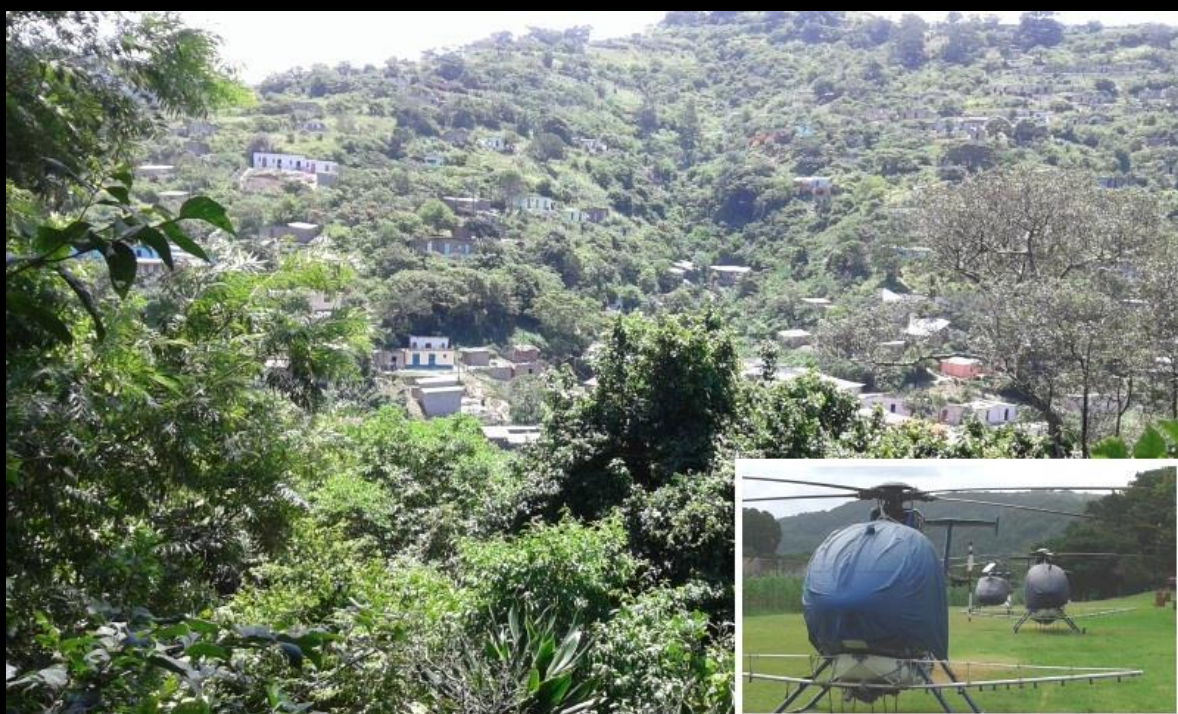

(a) not to be deprived of freedom arbitrarily or without just cause;

(b) not to be detained without trial;

(c) to be free from all forms of violence from either public or private sources;

(d) not to be tortured in any way; and

(e) not to be treated or punished in a cruel, inhuman or degrading

28. CHILDREN



(1) Every child **has the right**—

(c) to basic nutrition, **shelter**, basic health care services **and social services**;

(d) to be protected **from** maltreatment, neglect, **abuse or** degradation;

(h) to have a legal practitioner **assigned to the child** by the state, and at state expense, **in civil proceedings affecting the child**, if substantial injustice **would** otherwise result; **and**

(2) A **child's** best interests are of paramount importance in every matter concerning the **child**.

(3) In this section “**child**” means a person under the age of 18.

(a) do not discriminate on the basis of race; (b) are registered with the state; and (c) maintain standards that are not inferior to standards at comparable public educational institutions.



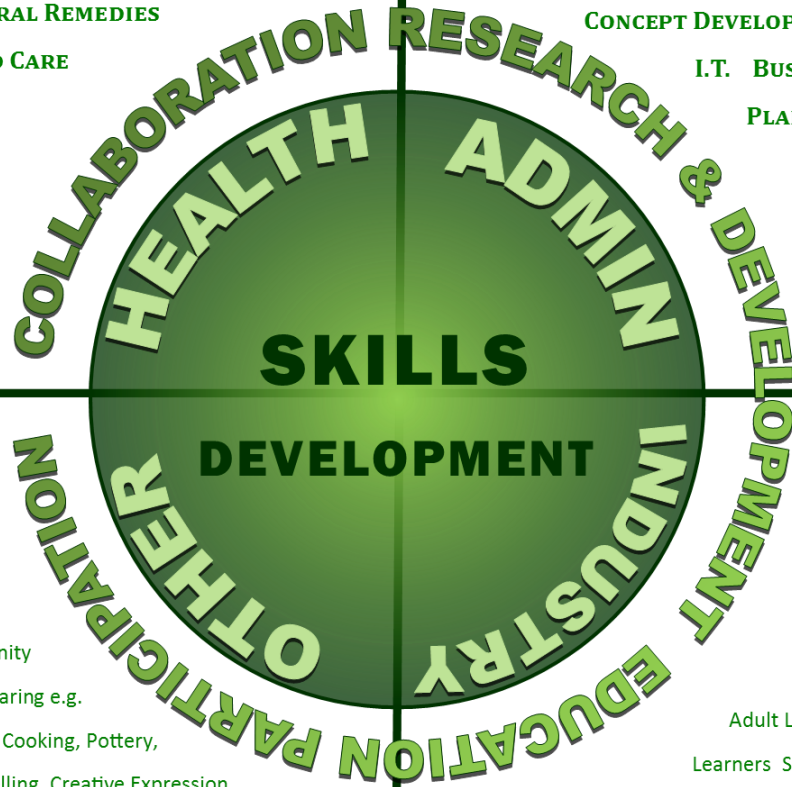

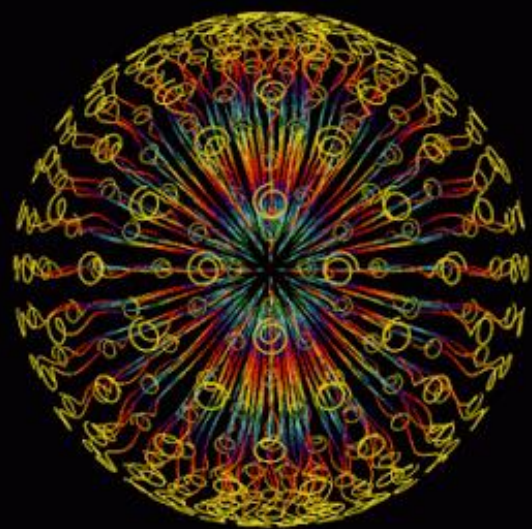

31. CULTURAL, RELIGIOUS AND LINGUISTIC COMMUNITIES



(1) Persons belonging to a cultural, religious or linguistic community may not be denied the right, with other members of that community—

(a) to enjoy their culture, practise their religion and use their language; and

(b) to form, join and maintain cultural, religious and linguistic associations and other organs of civil society.

32. ACCESS TO INFORMATION



(1) Everyone has the right of access to—

(a) any information held by the state; and

(b) any information that is held by another person and that is required for the exercise or protection of any rights.

33. JUST ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION

- (1) **Everyone has the right to administrative action that is lawful, reasonable and procedurally fair.**
- (2) **Everyone whose rights have been adversely affected by administrative action has the right to be given written reasons.**

(3) **National legislation must be enacted to give effect to these rights, and must—**

(a) **provide for the review of administrative action by a court or, where appropriate, an independent and impartial tribunal;**

(b) **impose a duty on the state to give effect to the rights in subsections (1) and (2); and**

(c) **promote an efficient administration.**

35. ARRESTED, DETAINED AND ACCUSED PERSONS

- (1) Everyone who is arrested for allegedly committing an offence has the right—**
- (a) to remain silent;**
 - (b) to be informed promptly—**
 - (i) of the right to remain silent; and**
 - (ii) of the consequences of not remaining silent;**
 - (c) not to be compelled to make any confession or admission that could be used in evidence against that person;**

36. LIMITATION OF RIGHTS





36. LIMITATION OF RIGHTS

36. (1) The rights in the Bill of Rights may be limited only in terms of law of general application to the extent that the limitation is reasonable and justifiable in an open and democratic society based on human dignity, equality and freedom, taking into account all relevant factors, including—

- (a) the nature of the right;
- (b) the importance of the purpose of the limitation;
- (c) the nature and extent of the limitation;
- (d) the relation between the limitation and its purpose; and
- (e) less restrictive means to achieve the purpose.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1) or in any other provision of the Constitution, no law may limit any right entrenched in the Bill of Rights.

**38. ENFORCEMENT
OF RIGHTS**





38. ENFORCEMENT OF RIGHTS

Anyone listed in this section has the right to approach a competent court, alleging that a right in the Bill of Rights has been infringed or threatened, and the court may grant appropriate relief, including a declaration of rights. The persons who may approach a court are—

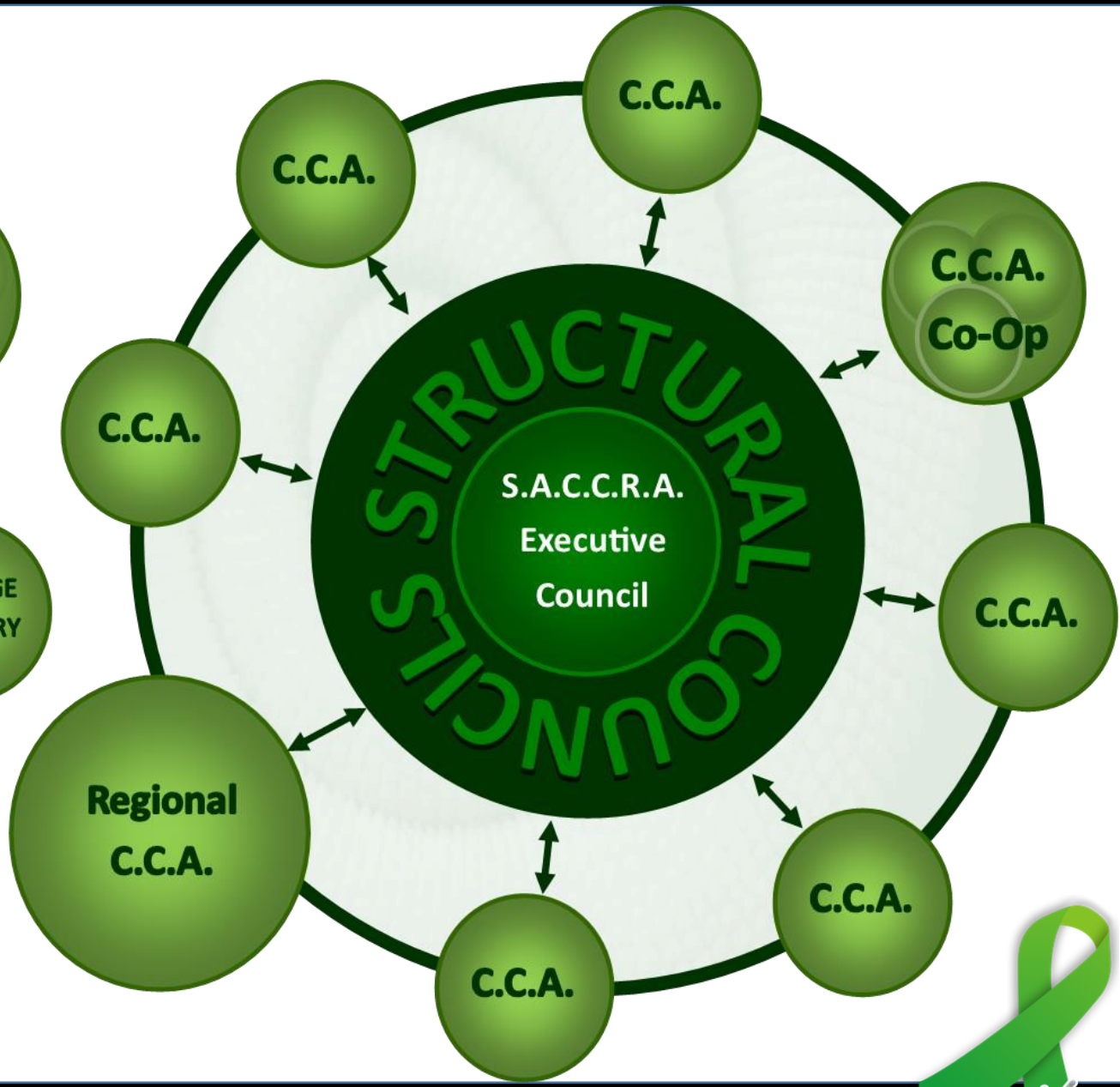
- (a) anyone acting in their own interest;
- (b) anyone acting on behalf of another person who cannot act in their own name;
- (c) anyone acting as a member of, or in the interest of, a group or class of persons;
- (d) anyone acting in the public interest; and
- (e) an association acting in the interest of its members.

39. (1) When interpreting the Bill of Rights, a court, tribunal or forum—

(a) must promote the values that underlie an open and democratic society based on human dignity, equality and freedom;

(b) must consider international law; and

(c) may consider foreign law

(3) The Bill of Rights does not deny the existence of any other rights or freedoms that are recognised or conferred by common law, customary law or legislation, to the extent that they are consistent with the Bill.
